Thank you for your support and see you all in September.



The Multi Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH) is a partnership between Devon children's social care, education and youth services, Devon National Health Services, Devon and Cornwall Police and probation service working together to safeguard children and young people.

**If a child is at immediate risk contact the police on 999.**

## Free school meals holiday voucher scheme

Pupils in Devon who currently receive free school meals will automatically be [sent supermarket vouchers to help them buy food](#) during the summer break. All our parents and carers will receive the vouchers from our Family Liaison Sharon. Please look out for an email from Sharon and get in touch in case you did not receive it. Please make sure the email address we have available for you is up to date.



If you are not sure, just call in and we will check it for you. You can also contact the Devon County Council free school meals team if you were expecting to receive vouchers but did not. You can email them at [freeschoolmeals@devon.gov.uk](mailto:freeschoolmeals@devon.gov.uk) or call their education helpline on [0345 155 1019](tel:03451551019).

The vouchers - worth £105 per child (£15 for each week of the seven week break) can be redeemed in major supermarkets across Devon including Sainsburys, Tesco, Morrisons, Asda, Aldi, M&S Food and Waitrose. Arrangements are in place for families who cannot get to a supermarket.

If your child does not currently receive free school meals but you think they qualify due to a change in your family circumstances, [please apply online through the Devon Citizen Portal](#) as soon as possible in order to receive the vouchers for the summer holiday.


