Dear Parents and Carers,

Unfortunately, we are seeing an increase in COVID 19 cases across the north of Devon and our catchment area. We have not had a case in school yet, but do have pupils and staff self-isolating after coming into close contact with a confirmed case. This is only a couple of people at the moment and we hope that we manage to continue to keep Pathfield COVID free.

Our control measures are still in place and we have not reintroduced anything at this point, but I would just like to remind you of how you can help us keep everyone safe.

- If your child or any member of your household develop symptoms, please inform school and follow the self-isolation guidance. Book a PCR test for anyone showing symptoms.
- If you have any doubt about illness we would be really grateful if you didn't send your child in. Any child who develops symptoms whilst at school has to isolate from the class and we shall call their family for immediate pick up. We will recommend you book a local PCR test (postal tests are available in school but they take a lot longer to get the results).
- Self-testing lateral flow tests are available from school for all secondary aged pupils; please let us know if you would like a set sending home.
- We will follow public health advice if there are any confirmed cases in school, this will mean closing that bubble and any close contacts to self-isolate for a 10 period.

I am sorry to have to run through this all again but know you will appreciate the measures that we have in place to keep you child and our school community safe.

All events are currently under review and we shall be making decisions regarding these as information becomes available. Transitions are continuing where possible but again will be reviewed and may not involve all pupils.

Please keep in touch and let us know if you have any questions or concerns about our COVID 19 processes.


